26-29 marzo 2009 en Nuevo León, Monterrey (México). En las últimas décadas del siglo anterior el deterioro ecológico de nuestro planeta, derivado de las actividades humanas se ha hecho evidente. La incidencia de catástrofes más severas en todo el mundo en las últimas décadas, ha llevado a una preocupación más seria, por lo que se ha denominado "El Cambio Climático", vinculado al aumento de las temperaturas globales, debido, entre otras causas, al efecto invernadero derivado de la mayor presencia atmosférica de dióxido de carbono, producto de la combustión.
